Directions and Guidelines.

Using Microsoft Word you will create a state report including the following information about the state that you have chosen. Each page will be a page. You can display the information on each page however you would like. Just be sure that it has ALL the information along with a title. If you need to use more than one page per topic, you may, just be sure to include it in your Table of Contents!

- Page 1: Cover Page- Include the name of your state, your name, and the due date of the report.
- Page 2: Table of contents. Just as I have taught in class
- Page 3: Location of your state. Show the entire United States with YOUR state highlighted.
- Page 4: What's in a Name? Tell me how your state got it's name. Add your state's nickname on this page, too. Why does it have this nickname?
- Page 5: History. Write 5-7 sentences on the history of how your state became part of the United States.
- Page 6: State Flag. (4 sentences about the state flag)
- Page 7: State Seal. (4 sentences about the state seal)
- Page 8: State Flower. (4 sentences about the state flower)
- Page 9: State Bird. (4 sentences about the state bird)
- Page 10: Famous People. Name at least 4 famous people who were born in this state and write why they are famous. Include pictures.
- Page 11: Visitors Guide: Name and describe 3 places that YOU would want to visit if you got a chance to go to your state as well as why. Include pictures.
- Page 12: Weather. Tell me the average temperature each month in your state. Tell me the highest and the lowest temperature recorded in your state.
- Page 13: Free page. Add pictures and/or anything else you learned about your state while doing your research.
- Page 14: Evaluation. Answer these questions... Did you enjoy doing this report? Why? What was the most interesting thing you learned about your state? What was the hardest part of this report? What part was the most fun?
- Page 15: Bibliography.
